- Varietal: 100% 777 clone of Pinot Noir
- Farming: La Colina Vineyard and La Sierra Vineyards planted in 1999-2001.
- Aged two years in oak.
- Production: 90 Cases

Palette: Soft Smoky Tannins, Vanilla, Earthy, Red Fruit
