



## 2013 BEACON HILL VINEYARD PINOT NOIR



This wine reveals the purest terroir of our Estate as a blending of the two oldest blocks on our Beacon Hill Vineyard. Grown on self-rooted vitis vinifera vines planted in 1988 and 1989. 2013 was to be the hottest growing season on record until heavy rains completely changed the structure of the wines of this special vintage.

- Varietal: 100% Pinot Noir, blend of Pommard and Wadenswil clones.
- Farming: Beacon Hill Vineyard planted in 1988, LIVE certified, salmon safe, self-rooted Pommard and Wadenswil clones that are adjacent to our winery and tasting room. Harvested post-rain.
- 33% New Oak, 67% Neutral
- Production: 90 Cases
