



2013 CHEHALEM MT. VINEYARD PINOT NOIR



This wine is a little piece of Oregon wine industry history in a bottle. This is the very last vintage from the very first vineyard that Dick Erath planted in the late 1960's. Very rarely do you have an opportunity to try Oregon's old vine Pinot Noir from an outstanding vineyard.

- Varietal: 100% Pinot Noir
- Farming: Chehalem Mountain Vineyard planted in 1968 and dry farmed. Harvested October 15th—post 2013 rains.
- Destemmed, Native Fermentation, 11 months barrel aged.
- Production: 25 Cases

Nose: Anise, Licorice, Earthiness

Palette: Beautifully Balanced Earth and Fruit
