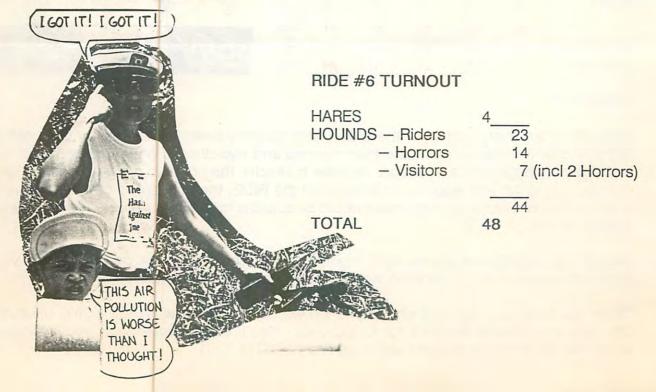
As a token of the PACK's esteem, "U-Bend" was invited into the middle to quaff a jar as thank's for her sterling efforts as "Haberdash".

#### MEMBER'S IN ACTION

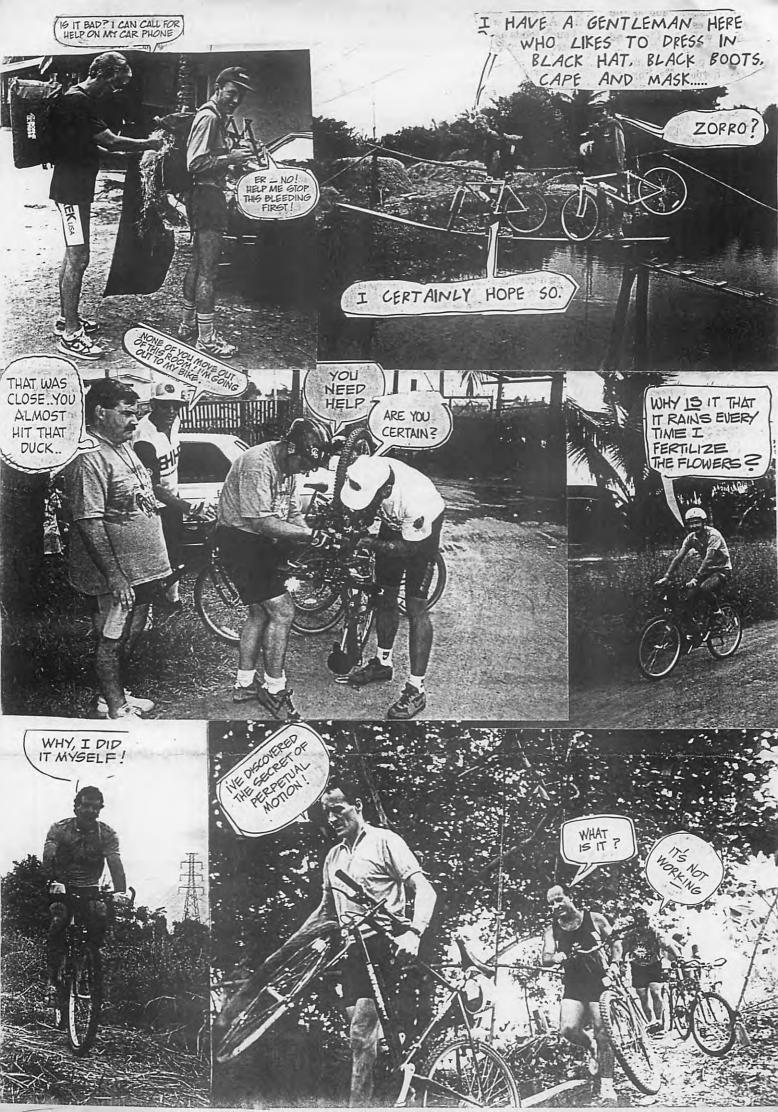

Your new Fisher MountainBike is an investment in a lifetime of pleasurable cycling. Whether you ride on the road or on the trail, your Fisher MountainBike will get you there in comfort and safety. The objective of this Owner's Manual is to give you the information you need for safe and reliable cycling wherever you travel.

This manual is in three parts. Part I covers fit, to make sure the Fisher MountainBike you buy is the one that's right for your bodily dimensions. Part II covers the basics of safety for both road and offroad riding. Part III shows you how to keep your new Fisher MountainBike in top condition for safe riding and years of pleasure. We urge you to read every word in this manual thoroughly, and to use it to maintain your Fisher Mountain-Bike for the lifetime of cycling pleasure you have purchased. For the sheer pleasure of trail riding in a mountain wilderness, for commuting to work on city streets, or for taking long distance trips on the highway as well as on the trail, your Fisher MountainBike is truly an all purpose machine.

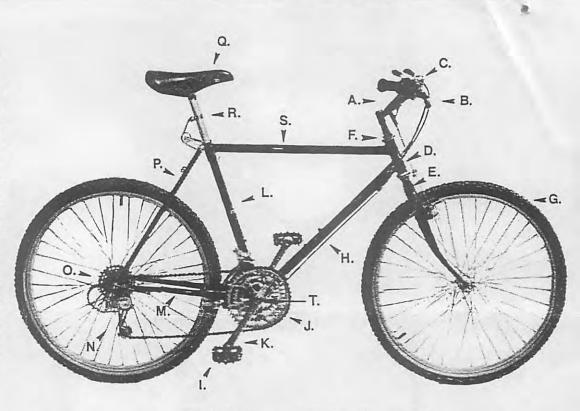


FIGURE 1: The anatomy of a Fisher Mountain Bike.



FITTING THE BIKE

#### Fitting the FISHER MOUNTAINBIKE to You

Before we start, look at Fig. 1, the Anatomy of a Fisher MountainBike. Take just a few minutes to acquaint yourself with the parts of the bicycle, to make sure we talk the same language and to help clarify these instructions as we go along. Fig. 1 shows: "A," Handlebars. "B" Brake lever. "C" Shift lever. "D" Steering head. "E," Fork. "F," Headset locknut, washer and adjustable cone. "G," Wheel, tire and hub. "H," Downtube. "I," Pedal. "J," Chainwheel, "K," Crank. "L," Seat tube. "M," chain stay. "N," Rear derailleur. "O," Freewheel. "P," Seat stay. "Q," Seat. "R," Seat post. "S," Top tube. "T," bottom bracket centerline.

Bike sizes are expressed in inches. These inches relate to the length of the seat tube ("L" in Fig. 1) from the centerline of the bottom bracket axle ("T" in Fig. 1) to the center of top tube, seat tube junction. Fisher MountainBikes' bottom brackets are higher up off the ground for safe clearance on rough trails. Thus the seat tube is shorter than on a road bike. A road bike bottom bracket is closer to the ground, so it has a longer seat tube. What this means is that if a 21 inch road bike fits you, for example, then your mountain bike size would be 19 inches.

The easiest way to find the right size frame is simply to straddle the bike with your shoes on. If you have an inch and a half to two inches of clearance between you and the top tube then you have a bike that fits you. Fig. 2 shows this clearance between rider and bike. Correct sizing is as simple as that.

#### SEAT HEIGHT

The correct seat height for riding on a flat surface, or when pedalling uphill, is when your leg is slightly bent at the knee when your foot (with shoes on) is on a pedal and the crank is parallel to the seat tube, as shown in Fig. 3.
