

When the Hare had given the ROLL-OFF time as 10:00 the night before there were many of us who did not believe that it was humanly possible to set a TRAIL to match that of RIDE #18, but, this dynamic duo proved all the skeptics well and truly wrong. The Co-Hare had predicted a tougher TRAIL running to around 35kms that would take two to three hours to RIDE and yes, he is clairvoyant. It was an absolutely superb RIDE from start to finish and I could not find enough superlatives in the dictionary to do it justice.

Promptly at 10:00 the Pack set off with their bums resting gingerly on their saddles after the exertions of the day before.
