Qualifications

- Subscribe to the Bible League International statement of faith as established by the National Association of Evangelicals.
- Have a desire to reach the unreached with the Word of God.
- Want to promote the ministry of Bible League International enthusiastically to your church.

Responsibilities

- Pray for Bible League International ministry and its success in serving the under-resourced Church globally through the provision of Bibles, biblical resources, and training to transform lives worldwide through God's Word.
- Remain informed of current Bible League International ministry and educate your church accordingly (i.e. through bulletin announcements and newsletters.)
- Promote Bible League International programs in your congregation, Sunday School, Vacation Bible School, youth groups, and adult study groups.
- Attend meetings and functions of your Division.
- Promote your Division's fund-raising projects, encourage people to attend, place announcements, prayer requests, and updates in church newsletter, bulletin, etc.
- Promote any fundraising efforts in your local church for Bible League International and turn donations in to your Division treasurer.
- Asking permission of appropriate church leadership, implement Testimony Letter (Love Letter) campaign in your church and/or request special offerings for Bible League International.
- Connect with church leadership with the purpose of providing a ministry of prayer for the church and members. Share prayer requests with the BLV prayer team as appropriate.
