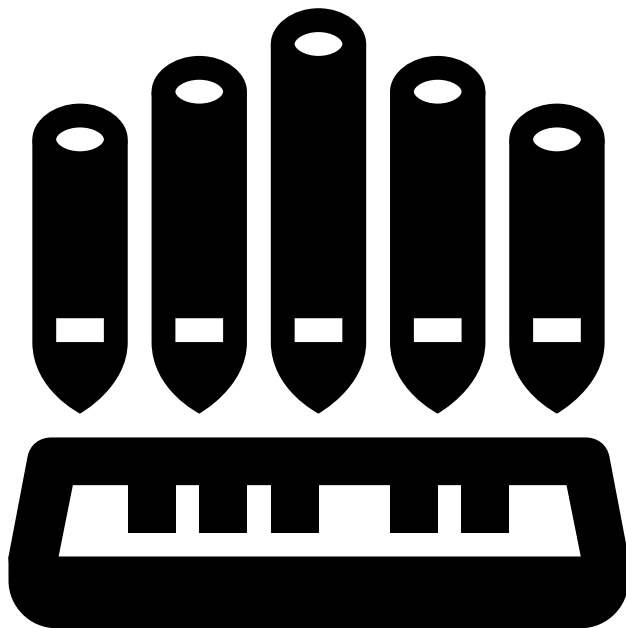


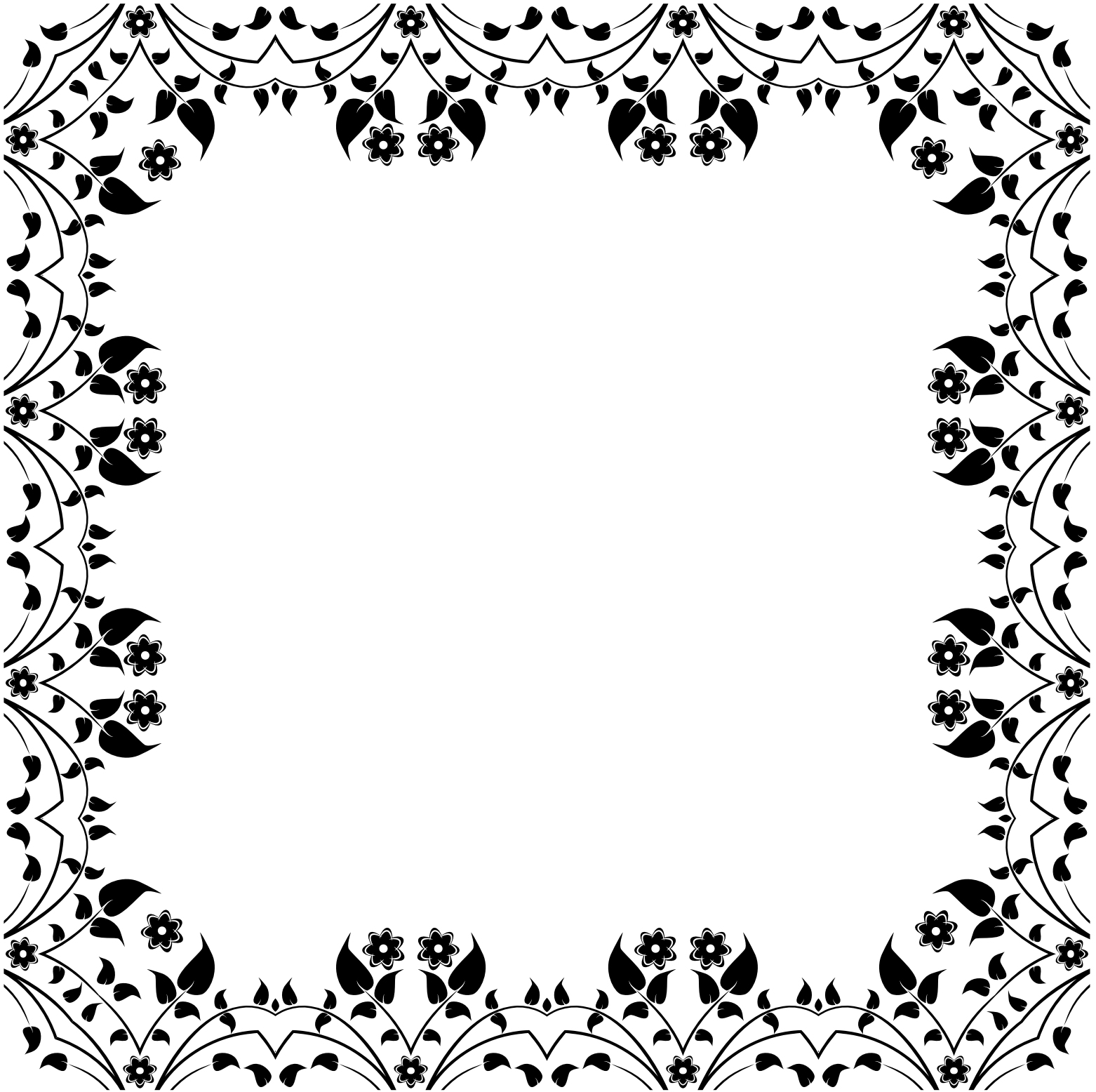

Baroque is used to describe a decorated and elaborate style of art and music that was created in Europe from 1600-1750 C.E..



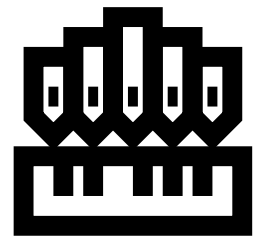
During this time in history, the Thirty Years' War was being fought in Europe and the United States was being resettled by British colonists.



During this time, patrons would hire artists and composers. The main patrons were the church and wealthy people.



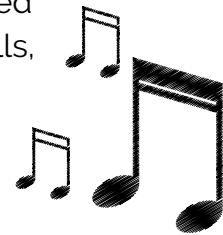
Some of the best pipe organs were built during the Baroque era. Violins and trumpets were also popular instruments in Baroque music.



A woodwind instrument makes a sound when you blow down a long tube. Recorders, oboes and flutes are all part of the woodwind family of instruments.



Baroque music was filled with fancy sounding frills, drama and contrast.



# REVIEW CARDS

**Opera** was a drama set to music for singers and instrumentalists. Operas were a popular form of music in the Baroque era.



A collection of dances that were similar in sound was called a **suite**. People would gather to listen and dance to suites..



A **concerto** was a musical form for a solo instrument or voice with an orchestra



Handel was a German composer who wrote for princes and kings. "Fireworks", "Water Music" and "The Messiah" are some of his most famous works.



Vivaldi was red-headed Italian composer who wrote hundreds of pieces, many of which were for a girls' orphanage in Venice. His most-known work is "Four Seasons".



Bach is the most famous Baroque composer. He composed new music every Sunday for his patron church. He came from a musical family and 3 of his 20 children were also composers.
