Qualifications:

- Bachelor's Degree (music endorsement licensure preferred)
- Experience teaching music to children
- Highly-motivated, organized, and able to work independently
- Excellent oral and written communication skills, including the ability to collaborate with staff
- An understanding of learning disabilities and differentiated instruction
- In depth music knowledge

Responsibilities:

- Teach music to students including voice, tone, tempo, and rhythm skills.
- Develop and maintain an effective music education program including musical instruments for students.
- Maintain lesson plans and instructional materials for students.
- Order music materials and supplies within the designated budget.
- Organize special programs (fine arts field trip, school chorus, technology music program).

Other Duties as Assigned:

- Possibility of additional hours for special projects, as directed by the Head of School
