## UPLOAD RESUME – README

### **Bot Overview**

This bot performs the following:

- The bot logs in to a given Automation Anywhere Account through Internet Explorer.
- It then navigates to the Group named “Group: RPA Career and Jobs”
- It then uploads each resume to the group, and includes a title and the resume user name(if the resume names are in the correct format, for more see the Parameter names)
- It then logs each resume and the time it was uploaded to the log file.
- Lastly, it moves each resume to the resumes already uploaded folder, so the same resume isn’t inadvertently uploaded multiple times
- This bot also creates an “Error Folder” with “Logs” and “Snapshots” Subfolders as shown below in the AA Directory hierarchy if there are errors.
- The path for Bot Store: -  
`$AAApplicationPath$\Automation Anywhere\My Tasks\Bot Store\ Resume Upload - Peopleshores`

### **Pre – Requisites**

- Automation Anywhere Enterprise v11.3
- Resumes to upload
- Automation Anywhere account
- Internet Explorer

### **Installation**

- Download the bot from Bot store
- Unzip the zip archive
- For first time users, create "Bot Store" folder under<AA Directory>/My Tasks (on your local disk)

- Copy folder "Resume Upload" to above created Bot Store folder inside<AA Directory>/My Tasks in Automation Anywhere folder on your local disk

**Create the following folder structure for the content in the AA Dir:**

- <AA Directory>
  - o My Tasks
    - Bot Store
      - Resume Upload – Peopleshores (Folder)
        - o Error Folder
          - Logs (Folder)
          - Snapshots (Folder)
        - o Input Files (Folder)
          - Name\_Resume1
          - Name\_Resume2
          - ...
          - Resume upload log.txt
        - o My Tasks
          - Resume Upload.atmx

**How to use the bot:**

**Use the following information to configure your bot:**

Parameter Name	Type	Direction	Additional Info
vTask	String	Input	<b>REQUIRED Field.</b> This is the file path to the folder where the files are located. To change it, you must go into the code and change line 2.
vErrorFolder	String	Input	This is the file path to the Error Folder. By default, it is inside the Task Folder. If you wish to change it, you must go into the code and change line 3.

vSnapshotFolder	String	Input	This is the file path to the Error Snapshot Folder. By default, it is inside the Error Folder. If you wish to change it, you must go into the code and change line 5.
vLogFolder	String	Input	This is the file path to the Error Log Folder. By default, it is inside the Error Folder. If you wish to change it, you must go into the code and change line 4.
vResumesToBeUploaded	String	Input	This is the file path to the folder of resumes to be uploaded. By default, it is inside the Task folder. If you wish to change it, you must go into the code and change line 17.
vAlreadyUploadedResumes	String	Input	This is the file path to the folder of resumes already uploaded. By default, it is inside the Input Files folder. If you wish to change it, you must go into the code and change line 18.
vLog	String	Input	This is the file path to the folder of resumes already uploaded. By default, it is inside the Task folder. If you wish to change it, you must go into the code and change line 19.
vDelay	String	Input	This is the delay given for inputting the description. By default, it starts at 12 seconds and increases every iteration. It can be changed at line 20.
vCount	String	Input	The total numbers of postings created. This is purely internal and there is no need to change it.
vResumeBelongsTo	String	Input	This is the owner of each resume. The formatting for the filename of each resume is expected to be Name_Resume and is used internally.
vMessage	String	Input	This is the message associated with each resume. It can be changed in line 45.

### **Error Handling**

- Each Bot folder contains the below hierarchy.
  - o Error Folder

- Logs
    - Error Logs Month-Day-Year.txt: In case of any error, this file captures the error message
  - Snapshots
    - Error Snap Month-Day-Year Hour-Minute.png: In case of any error, this file captures the screenshot of the error.
- Status of Bot is set to failed.

### More Information

- User may need to edit variable vTask to reflect the location/path where the bot folder is located.
- Care is required during login; if extra whitespace characters are included, that may lead to issues
- Bot should work whether or not user is already logged into their AA account.
- Resumes file names are expected to be in the format of Name\_Resume.
