

Service Check and Remediation Bot – Paramatrix Technologies – ReadMe

Bot Overview

This bot performs the following:

- Checks the status of all the services mentioned by the user.
- If any service is stopped, the bot proceeds to start the service.
- The bot will automatically generate an Output Log.

((Note: Some services needs admin privileges to start. Install this bot in Admin User and Run this bot as an admin.))

Pre-Requisites

- Automation Anywhere Enterprise Client v11.3.2

Installation

- Download the bot from Bot Store.
- Double click the installation file (.msi) and follow steps mentioned on screen.
- In case the My MetaBots (.metabot file) is not copied to local My MetaBots folder, kindly copy paste from the bot installed location.
- The Bot folder structure would be as follows:
 - <AA Application Directory> For Eg: "C:\Users\<username>\Documents\Automation Anywhere Files\
 - Automation Anywhere
 - My Tasks
 - Bot Store
 - ServiceCheckAndRemediation-ParamatrixTechnologies
 - My Tasks
 - My MetaBots
 - Input Folder
 - Output Folder
 - Error Folder

How to Use the BOT?

- Navigate to the **Input Folder**, Open "**Input_Service_Names_CSV.csv**" file and Enter list of Services Names. Eg: "wuaserv" for Windows Update Service.
- To fetch the services name of any service, Search Services in Start Menu → Double click on desired Service → Copy the **Service Name** and paste it in CSV of Input Folder.
Note: Do not mention the Display Name of the service. Service Name is required.
- Close the CSV file and Run the bot.

Variable Name	Description
vInputFolderPath	Contains the path of the Input Folder. If the path is changed, make sure to change the values of this variable to the desired path.
vInputPathCSV	Contains the path of the Input CSV. Mention Services Names in this CSV File. If the path is changed, make sure to change the values of this variable to the desired path.
vOutputFolderPath	Contains the path of the Output Folder. If the path is changed, make sure to change the values of this variable to the desired path.
vOutputPathCSV	Contains the path of the Output Log File. Contains the output results of the Bot. If the path is changed, make sure to change the values of this variable to the desired path.
vErrorFolderPath	Contains the path of the Error Folder. If the path is changed, make sure to change the values of this variable to the desired path.
vErrorPathCSV	Contains the path of the Error Log File. If any error occurs, it will be mentioned in this CSV. If the path is changed, make sure to change the values of this variable to the desired path.
