1. Introduction

This document contains all essential information for the user to make full use of this A2019 Dell Boomi Run Process package. It includes a description of the functions and capabilities and step-by-step procedures for setup & configuration.

1.1 Overview

This package integrates with Dell Boomi to list objects, execute Boomi Processes and retrieve the list of execution records.

In short, it can:

- List Atoms
- List Processes
- Execute a Process
- Retrieve the list of Execution Records

1.2 Use cases

The key use cases include:

- Run a Boomi Process from within RPA.

2. Requirements & Prerequisites

2.1 System Requirements

A2019.16+ Enterprise edition for the Bot (it uses interactive forms features from A2019.16).
The underlying package can be used with all versions of A2019.

2.2 Prerequisites

Dell Boomi Account and at least 1 Atom and at least 1 configured Dell Boomi Process

3. Getting Started

3.1 Quick Start

3.1.1 Setup

Import the Bot, open it and configure it.

3.1.2 Configuration and Use

Use the “Session Start” to configure your connection to Boomi.

“List Processes” / “List Atoms”: return a JSON list of Processes (deployed) or Atoms

Both lists can be converted to either a Table or a CSV like string using either of the 2 actions:

- ConvertProcessListToCSV / ConvertAtomListToCSV
- ConvertProcessListToTable

“Execute Process”: run a Dell Boomi Process

“List Execution Records”: list all Execution Records (as a Table)
