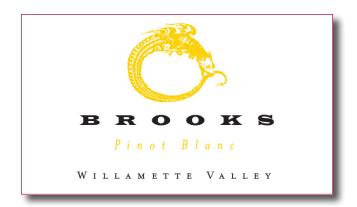

2017 VINTAGE: A WET, COOL SPRING DELAYED FLOWERING UNTIL LATE JUNE, WHICH SET THE STAGE FOR A LATER HARVEST THAN THE PREVIOUS THREE VINTAGES. HOT, DRY CONDITIONS PRE-VAILED THROUGH THE SUMMER, YIELD-ING HEAT SPIKES IN AUGUST. WITH A LARGER THAN NORMAL FRUIT SET, THE GRAPES ENJOYED LONG HANG TIME LEADING UP TO HARVEST. CONDITIONS COOLED AND BROUGHT IN SCATTERED RAINS WITH THE HARVEST, WHICH BE-GAN AT BROOKS ON THE 28TH OF SEP-TEMBER AND RAN THROUGH NOVEMBER 1ST, ALMOST RETURNING TO NORMAL AVERAGE HARVEST DATES IN THE WIL-LAMETTE VALLEY. THE WINES FROM THE VINTAGE SHOW FRESH FRUIT FLAVORS AND LIVELY ACIDITY. IN ALL, IT WILL BE REMEMBERED AS A CLASSIC VINTAGE IN OREGON!
