Re: Public Utility Commission of Texas Docket No. 44547 – Application of CenterPoint Energy Houston Electric, LLC to Amend a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity for a Proposed 345 kV Transmission Line within Grimes, Harris and Waller Counties

In April 2015, CenterPoint Energy Houston Electric, LLC (CenterPoint Energy) notified you that it had filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (PUC) to amend its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN). The CCN application requested authorization for CenterPoint Energy to construct new 345 kV transmission facilities either on or in close proximity to your property. The PUC assigned the CCN application to Docket No. 44547.

The PUC issued a final order in Docket No. 44547 on January 15, 2016, in which it approved the CCN application and designated route 1A-Modified (consisting of Segments B, F, LA, I3, LD, N1A, K3, N1C, H2, V2A, L3, A3, C3, D3A, M3, O3, P3, Q3, and R3) as the route along which CenterPoint Energy is authorized to construct the new transmission facilities. Route 1A-Modified, as approved by the PUC, is shown on the enclosed map. The route that was approved by the PUC does not cross your property, and your property is no longer the subject of a pending proceeding.

On April 14, 2016, the PUC granted a re-hearing. On April 28, 2016 the PUC issued a revised final order stating that the CenterPoint Energy project shall be constructed with monopoles except inside electric utility substations where tower structures may be used. This is the only substantive change that the PUC made to the January 15, 2016 final order.
