Note: The CAPA Conference Planning Committee reserves the right to make final selections to ensure balanced programming. Timely submission of a proposal does not guarantee selection. The committee reserves the right to solicit proposals for programs to ensure the diversity of program offerings.

Compensation: Each presenter will receive a \$350 honorarium for each session. Presenters will have the option to donate their honorarium back to CAPA.

Travel: All presenters will be responsible for making and paying for their own travel arrangements to and from the conference. CAPA may provide
