TIER 1 Physical	<p>Goal: To provide safety & keep a family together.</p> <p>Focus: At-risk families</p> <p>Help provide safety for children and meet state requirements in order to keep families together that would otherwise be in danger of losing custody of their children.</p>	<p>Goal: To stabilize a foster or kin placement or reunify a family.</p> <p>Help provide safety for children & meet state requirements in foster and/or kinship homes in order to help a child maintain a placement while their biological family works toward reunification.</p>	<p>Goal: To preserve adoptive placement or finalize adoption.</p> <p>Help provide support and resources for children whose biological parents' rights have been terminated and now need permanency, as well as support and resources for adoptive families and/or adoptive resources.</p>	<p>Goal: To help prepare a youth for independence.</p> <p>Help to provide support and resources for youth between the ages of 18-24 who are preparing to transition out of state care and into independent living.</p>
TIER 2 Relational	<p>Goal: To heal family and prevent removal.</p> <p>Help provide relational support and come alongside families that would otherwise be in danger of losing custody of their children, as well as relational support and guidance for at-risk children in the care of those families.</p>	<p>Goal: To support foster and kin families and reunify.</p> <p>Help provide support through relational connections with children who are in state custody, along with the foster family who has taken the child into their home. This box also includes opportunities to come</p>	<p>Goal: To support adoptive parents and children.</p> <p>Focus: Children whose biological parents have had their parental rights terminated; Adoptive Families</p> <p>Help provide support and come alongside children whose biological parents' rights have been terminated and now need a permanency plan (preferably adoption). This box also includes opportunities to relationally engage with adoptive families.</p>	<p>Goal: To build support network for youth.</p> <p>Journey with youth between the ages of 18-24 who are preparing to transition out of state care and into independent living by being a friend, support system, and consistent relationship in their life.</p>
TIER 3 Family	<p>Goal: To provide relationships to heal & strengthen families.</p> <p>Open your home in a time of crisis for children & families that would otherwise be in danger of losing custody of their children if there was no proactive intervention.</p>	<p>Goal: To recruit safe, quality temporary homes.</p> <p>Open your home temporarily for children whose biological parents have been determined by the state as unable to care for them at the current time. (However, the goal of this time is reunification with biological family.)</p>	<p>Goal: To find forever homes for children & youth.</p> <p>Focus: Children whose biological parents have had their parental rights terminated; Adoptive Families</p> <p>Open your home permanently for children whose biological parents' rights have been terminated & now need a forever home.</p>	<p>Goal: To deepen support for youth by providing "home".</p> <p>Open your home to youth between the ages of 18-24 who are preparing to transition out of state care and into independent living to be a safe and permanent place for them to come back to as they adjust to adult life.</p>
