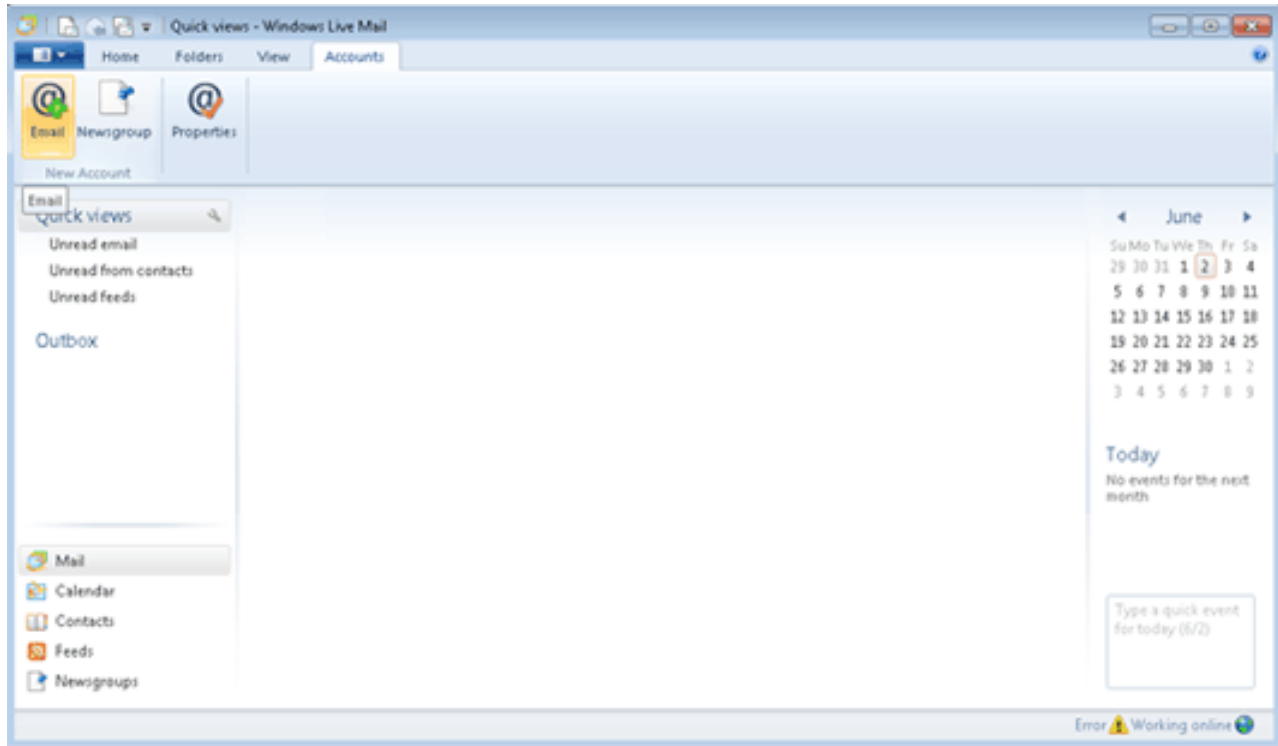
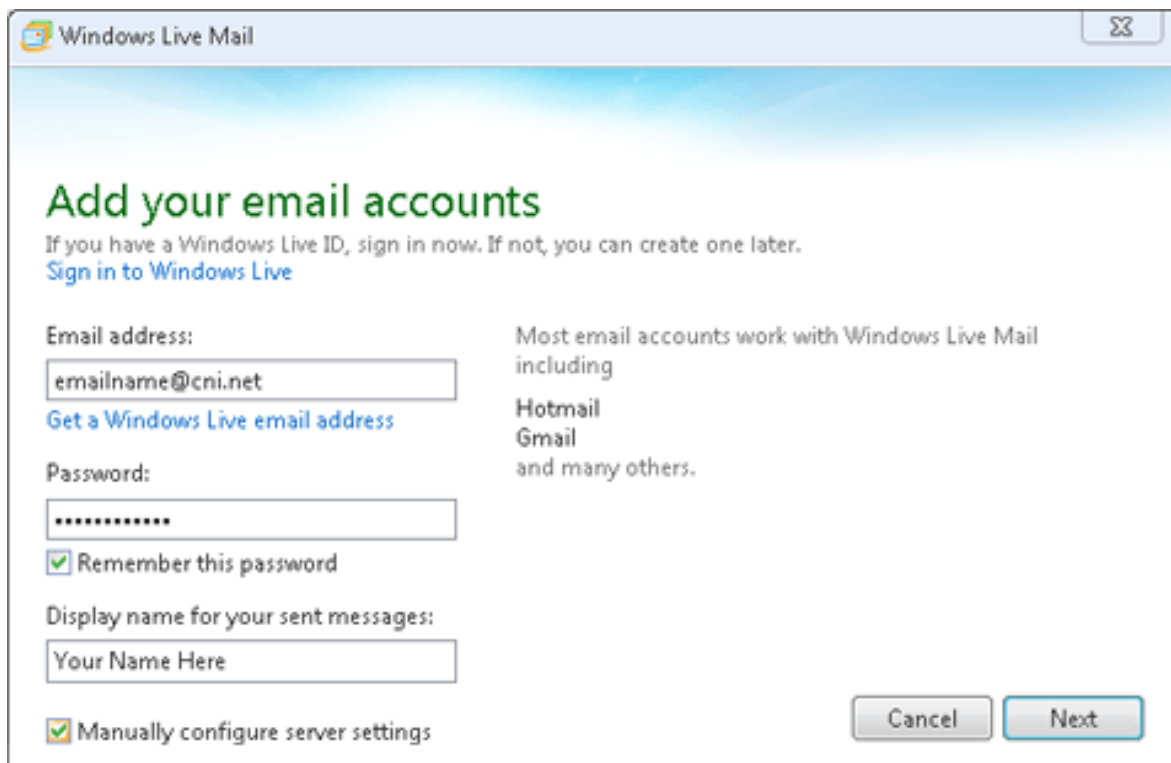


Open Windows Live Mail. When you first open the program, another window should open titled "Add your E-mail accounts." If you do not see this window, click on the "Accounts" tab, then click the button that says "E-mail."




Enter your E-mail address, password, and check the box that says "Manually configure server settings." You may also check the box that says "Remember this password" if you do not want to enter your password each time you check your E-mail. Click "Next."




In the next window, set the Server type to "POP." Set the "Server address" to "mail.cni.net" if your E-mail address ends in @cni.net. If your E-mail address ends in @cascadenetworks.net, set the server address to "mail.cascadenetworks.net" and if your E-mail address ends in @clatskanie.com, set your server address to "mail.clatskanie.com."

Your "Logon user name" is the first part of your E-mail address before the @ symbol. Make sure to check the box under Outgoing server information that says "Requires authentication."
