

2026/2027 Castle Trade Scholarship Terms and Conditions

The 2026/2027 Castle Trade Scholarship Program is open to those that:

- Have Canadian citizenship or Permanent Resident status.
- Have a Canadian SIN (Social Insurance Number)
- Are entering their full-time first or second year of an eligible skilled trade program at a recognized Canadian trade college; Apprenticeship applications are not eligible.
- A Castle Trade Scholarship is a non-repayable sum of \$2,500 presented to an eligible student to help with his/her/their Trade College tuition cost.
- Castle Trade Scholarship(s) will be awarded based on skilled trade students who demonstrate strong work ethics and character, academic and/or professional ambition, diligence, skillfulness, and achievement, as well as passion to inspire positive change in their community, not on financial need.
- The Scholarship program may be altered, amended, or discontinued at the discretion of Castle Building Centres Group Ltd.
- The decision of the Scholarship Selection Committee, an independent third party, is final and not open to appeals. A recipient is limited to one Scholarship through Castle Building Centres Group Ltd. per academic year.
- The Scholarship deadline for submission: August 14th, 2026.
- Scholarship recipient(s) will be notified by September 18th, 2026, and awarded their Scholarship in October 2026.

Failure to submit the Trade Scholarship application by the deadline date, August 14th, 2026, with the following will deem the student application incomplete and ineligible:

- Completed 2026/2027 Castle Trade Scholarship Application Form.
- Minimum 500-word essay describing your educational and work background, extracurricular activities, and community involvement over the past few years; your academic and career goals, and how you aspire to use your skilled trade to drive positive community impact.
- Copy of your 2026/2027 Full-time Admittance and Confirmed Acceptance from the college into your Trade program.
- Minimum of one letter of recommendation from either a teacher, principal, clergy, business, or community leader.
- Copy of one of the following:
 - Your Final High School Graduating Transcript or high school diploma.
 - Your GED certificate.
 - Copy of your first-year grades if entering the second year of trade program.
 - If you have not attended any schooling in the past 5 years, please provide your CV and/or your recent life/work experience.
