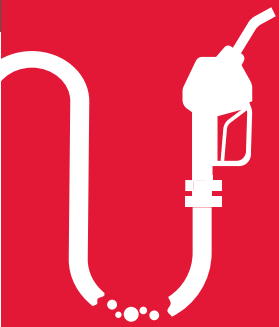




IS YOUR FUEL TANK WINTER READY?



KEEP BLOCKAGES OUT OF FUEL LINES

Tip: Avoid running your tank nearly empty to prevent water, sludge, and sediment build-up.

Why: This build-up can freeze and cause blockages and heater performance issues.

Solution: Keep your tank full and consider a filter package to maintain fuel purity.

PREVENT FUEL THEFT



Tip: Use a secure, durable tank that protects your fuel and pumping equipment.

Why: Fewer daylight hours in the winter increase risk of theft, especially at night.

Solution: Use Western Global fuel tanks with features like:

- Lockable equipment cabinet to secure equipment and ports.
- Concealed hinges and tamper-proof locking systems.
- Access manway to prevent lid removal.

ENSURE LEAK-FREE OPERATION



Tip: Regularly check your tank for leaks before harsh weather sets in.

Why: Cold weather can cause steel to contract, leading to leaks.

Solution:

- Detect the defect: Look for cracks and weather erosion.
- Monitor fuel levels: watch for increased rates of fuel consumption compared to regular usage, this could be due to a leak.
