

MDA Guidelines for CauseMatch Fundraising for Running a Safe Crowdfunding Campaign During the Corona Outbreak

- For dinner halls, conference halls, call centers, or any other gathering with tens to hundreds of people
- Ensure that there are sufficient stations for hand washing with soap. In addition, in the general area, provide hand sanitizers dispersed around the hall. The sanitizer should be alcohol based.
- In all places of gathering, there should be facial tissues available for people to wipe their nose and made accessible to all participants
- If possible, provisions should be made to provide additional restroom, reception, information and other facilities in order to reduce high density of people in a small place
- Unless disinfected between participants, avoid shared computer stations for participants or having participants using shared equipment
- The Ministry of Health bans gatherings of 100 or more
- In confined spaces, care should be taken to ventilate. If the event can be held in the open air tent, this is optimal.
- The frequency of cleaning should be increased in common areas such as dining room, toilets and counters.
- The surfaces will be cleaned using a bleaching agent containing at least 1.0% sodium hypochlorite sodium (eg bleach or alcohol-based disinfectants) at least 70% ethanol.
- Ensure that people with fever, cough, or difficulty breathing do NOT come to your event
- Care should be taken to wash hands with soap or disinfect hands in designated positions frequently, especially before and after a visit in the bathroom or before touching the food.
- People handling cash / checks should wear gloves or disinfect hands frequently
Avoid contact with eyes in nose and mouth with hands that have not been washed / disinfected.

🚫 Handshakes should be avoided

🚫 Avoid using shared computing stations for participants or contact with various accessories / equipment. If contact is made, wash hands with soap / disinfectant based on alcohol. If fever or respiratory symptoms have occurred, or any medical problems with one of the conference participants, MDA should be contacted by calling 101.

If necessary, the health clinic or emergency room physician may be contacted, but the clinic or emergency room must be notified in advance. In case a patient does enter a medical center, the mouth and nose should be covered with a surgical mask or other available cloth, and avoid traveling by public transport.
