- ◆ The 5th annual Kansas Disciples Men's Odyssey Experience will begin at 7:00 p.m. Sept 28.
- ◆ The Disciples Men's Odyssey Project came into being in 2015 as a way to help teen boys, and men in general, grow in faith and develop Christ-like character. The name comes from concepts that were presented at the 2014 Men's Retreat. At the 2014 retreat, attendees explored how to live a soul-filled life using ideas from Thomas Moore's book "Care of the Soul." One of these ideas dealt with how we become the men God created us to be using the metaphor of the ancient Greek myth of the Odyssey to illuminate scriptural teachings.
- ◆ The Odyssey retreat introduces men to the origins and goals of this project. Participants are given a copy of the 8 week expanded prayer journal/devotion guide called "A Daily Rule for Life." They are then instructed on how to use this material. Finally, retreat participants experience a monthly Men's Odyssey Group meeting.
- ◆ Do you want your teen son, or grandson, to develop Christ-like character?
- ◆ Do you have what it takes to develop Christ-like character in yourself?
