Campbell River Women's Hockey League Code of Conduct



- 1. Smoking, use of drugs, taking photos or videos, and children will not be permitted in the dressing room.
- 2. Any league member taking photographs or video during a league managed/ sponsored social event should attempt to obtain approval from other league members contained in the photo/ video prior to sharing the photos/ video on any email distribution, website, social media, etc.
- 3. Consumption of alcohol or use of drugs while playing hockey or just prior to a game will not be permitted. Use common sense; referees and/ or Executive Members/ Team Reps will have final call if they feel someone is not fit to play.
- 4. Hockey gear to be kept clean and properly aired.
- 5. Our league goal is to provide a positive and supportive environment. Players are expected to be as positive and encouraging as possible toward one another.
- 6. Players will also show respect to others at all times. This includes teammates, coaches, referees, opposing team, and fans.
- 7. Players are expected to demonstrate good sportsmanship (e.g., proper handshake at the end of the game, go quietly and immediately to the penalty box...etc.).
- 8. Keep negative comments to yourself.
- 9. All complaints are to be submitted in writing to the Executive.
- 10. Players are expected to contact the Team Representative if they are unable to attend practice or game.

Players will be expected to be paid in full by September 1 for cash transactions. Post dated cheques will be accepted dated for September 30 (for the remaining fees following the \$100 deposit). Any player with a balance owing on their fees will not be permitted to play.
