The South Huron Soccer Club (SHSC) is committed to fostering an accessible environment for all members of the club. It is our goal to respect the dignity and independence of individuals with disabilities, and provide them with a similar experience to other club members.

To the best of our ability with our current resources, the SHSC will ensure that:

- All communication with individuals with disabilities will be done taking their specific disability into consideration
- All individuals that require assistive devices, service animals or support persons will be accommodated
- The public will be given notice of any temporary disruptions to facilities or games and practices
- All SHSC members will have the opportunity to receive training on how to interact and communicate with individuals with disabilities, if requested
- All feedback regarding our Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Policy will be considered by the executive
- All SHSC documents will be available in formats that accommodate an individual's disability
- All individuals with disabilities can access our facilities as independently and safely as possible

All members must have equal opportunity when participating in club activities, and the concerns and needs of each member must be considered. Discrimination towards any member of the SHSC will not be tolerated.
