SASKATOON MINOR HOCKEY - 2023-2024 GAME TIMING INFORMATION

U15A City-Wide:

NOTE: Playing time in U15A regular season games is 1 3/4 hours with the ice time allotted at 2.0 hrs. = 1 3/4 hours playing time & 15 minutes for <u>one</u> flood after the 2^{nd} period. All U15A games will start on clean ice. One (1) 30-second timeout per team per game in U15A City-Wide.

5-minute warm up 1st period: 20-minutes stop time; 2nd period: 20-minutes stop time; 3rd period: 20 minutes stop time

U13 A, B & C; U15 B & C; U18 B & C:

NOTE: Playing time in U13 A, B & C; U15 B & C; and U18 A, B & C regular season games is 1 1/2 hours with the ice time allotted at 1 3/4 hours = 1 1/2 hours playing time & 15 minutes for one flood;

5-minute warm up 1st period 20-minutes stop time 2nd period 20-minutes stop time

3rd period 20 minutes stop time** (or)

**Where there is less than five (5) minutes remaining in the allotted ice time (arena clocks used as standard time) with more than two (2) minutes remaining on the game clock, the timekeepers will notify the referee during the first available stoppage in play (by pressing the buzzer) & adjust the clock down to two (2) minutes to be played stop time.

**No timeouts permitted in <u>regular season</u> league play.

U18A (1:45 total ice time slot with one flood):

5-minute warm up 1st period **15-minutes stop time** 2nd period 20-minutes stop time

3rd period 20 minutes stop time** (or)

**Where there is less than five (5) minutes remaining in the allotted ice time (arena clocks used as standard time) with more than two (2) minutes remaining on the game clock, the timekeepers will notify the referee during the first available stoppage in play (by pressing the buzzer) & adjust the clock down to two (2) minutes to be played stop time.

U11 A, B, C & D (1 1/4 hours playing time - flood end of every game whenever possible):

3-minute warm up (maximum)

1st period 20 minutes straight time 2nd period 20 minutes straight time

3rd period remaining time in the allotted ice time - straight time (3rd period can be longer than 20 min)

U9 A, B, C & D (**55-minute playing time - flood end of every two games):

*Half Ice format – 3-minute warm up (maximum)

1st period 24 minutes straight time 2nd period 24 minutes straight time

SASK. FEMALE HOCKEY LEAGUE (U18 AA, U15 AA, U13AA & U18 A & U15 A FEMALE):

NOTE: Playing time in U18 A & U15 A games is 1.5 hours with the ice time allotted at 2.0 hours = 1.5 hours playing time and 30 minutes for <u>a flood after each period.</u> U18 AA, U15 AA & U13AA playing time -1.75 hours with ice time allotted at 2.25 hours = 1.75 hours playing time & 30 minutes for two floods. One (1) 30-second timeout per team per game in SFHL.

5-minute warm up

1st period 20-minutes stop time 2nd period 20-minutes stop time

3rd period 20 minutes stop time** (or):

**Where there is less than five (5) minutes remaining in the allotted ice time (arena clocks used as standard time) with more than two (2) minutes remaining on the game clock, the timekeepers will notify the referee during the first available stoppage in play (by pressing the buzzer) & adjust the clock down to two (2) minutes to be played stop time.

SASKATCHEWAN AA HOCKEY LEAGUE – U15AA, U16AA & U18AA:

Flood after every period and between games; One (1) 30-second timeout per team per game allowed.

10-15 minute warm up on dirty ice and then flood

1st period - 20-minute stop time; 2nd period - 20-minute stop time 3rd period - 20 minutes stop time U13AA - 5-10 minute warm-up on clean ice and then 3 x 20 minutes stop time with flood between each period.

** REMINDER THAT ONLY THE STARTING LINE UPS SHOULD BE ON THE ICE WHEN RETURNING FROM INBETWEEN PERIOD FLOODS. ALL OTHER PLAYERS ARE TO PROCEED STRAIGHT TO THE BENCH.
