

La Ronge Minor Hockey Player's Code of Conduct

It is the intention of this guideline to promote fair play and respect for all participants within La Ronge Minor Hockey. The intent of the Players' Pledge of Conduct is to positively influence players' behaviour and to identify La Ronge Minor Hockey's expectations of acceptable conduct both on and off the ice.

PLAYERS' PLEDGE

- 1. I will play hockey because I want to, not because others or coaches want me to.
- 2. I will play by the rules of hockey and in the spirit of the Game.
- 3. I will control my temper understanding that fighting or "mouthing-off" can spoil the activity for everyone.
- 4. I will respect my opponents both on and off the ice.
- 5. I will do my best to be a true team player.
- 6. I will remember that having fun, improving skills, making friends and doing my best are more important than winning.
- 7. I will acknowledge all good plays and performances including those of my teammates and my opponents.
- 8. I will remember that coaches and officials are there to help me. I will accept their decisions and show them respect.
- 9. I will attend school regularly, understanding that if I miss school without a valid reason, I may be asked not to participate in hockey until my school issues are resolved.
- 10. If I am having problems with any issues related to hockey including bullying or abuse, I will discuss these problems with my parents, my coaches or with another adult who will help me to address the problem.

I have read the Player's Pledge and I agree to follow it to the best of my ability.
