Recreational Leagues

U9 & U10 Recreational League

- Teams will play twice a week in May and June and wrap the season up early July with a Jamboree Event!
- No standings will be tabulated during the season.
- Format of each match: two 25 minute halves with a 5 minute half time break.
- Teams are encouraged to have one additional practice per week outside of their matches.
- 6 v 6 format on a ½ sized field (30-36 meters x 40-55 meters).
- Teams can make up to 6 substitutions at one time.
- Size 4 soccer ball to be used.
- Fields to be marked.
- Matches to be refereed.
- Offside rule will not be enforced.
- All other Laws of the Game will be enforced.

U11 & U12 Recreational League

- Teams will play twice a week in May and June and wrap the season up early July with a Jamboree Event!
- No standings will be tabulated during the season.
- Format of each match: two 30 minute halves with a 5 minute half time break.
- Teams are encouraged to have one additional practice per week outside of their matches.
- U11s & U12s will play 8 v 8 on a ¾ sized field (42-55 meters x 60-75 meters).
- Maximum 3 substitutions at one time.
- Size 4 soccer ball to be used.
- Fields to be marked.
- Matches to be refereed.

- All other Laws of the Game to be enforced.
