Went Over Policies and clarified or added:

- Additional Policy: If there is damage done to an arena, there will be a \$150 fine assessed. If the damage is above that amount, there will be the damage costs above the fine included with the fine.

- If you are having problems with ice surfaces please call everyone involved ahead of time.

- On the Web: If a team has not shown up by game time, they will be given a 15 min. grace, then the clock will start on running time. If the team has not shown up by the end of the first 20 min. period. The game is called.
