If different winner on Day 1 and Day 2, final game with highest ranked team having home ice advantage.

In Novice only, after 5 goals for individual, anymore goals scored by that individual will not count and play goes back to centre ice. This will include the playoffs.

If there is a 7 goal spread, the game will go to straight running time. The 2 minute penalty becomes a 3 minute penalty, etc. If the game gets back to under 7 goals the game goes back to stop time.
