11. Female Hockey – Frank: All teams had pretty good season. Bantams 13-24-3 lots of good games. 8 responded through email and 22 through mailing letters of invite.

12. Referee-In-Chief Report – Doug: Shortage of referees. Try and get some kids interested in referring from your associations. Had to cancel games because of shortage of refs.
