Pee Wee - identify 4-5 players in each community at both pee wee ages (minor & major) this would be around 75 players in each age group. divide this group between north and south (for practice reasons only) so there will be about 25-30 players meet every Sunday evening for a practice session with coaches selected by Interlake Minor Hockey Sunday evening (i.e. 5pm - 8pm) because most teams do not play at this time, if a player has a commitment with his/her club team, they play with the club team. Timeline: start November ??? End January??? - have to think about MAHA, provincials, playoffs - but get together again at end of March for a few practices at end of season: take the whole group and make 2 or 3 teams (no cuts) and enter at least 1 extended season. Tournament practices would be on skill development -puck handling, defenseman development, goaltending, skating, etc. We would revisit this at the scheduling meeting. Jay will have more info. tomorrow and get it out.
