- Suggestion to give surveys to older and/or graduating players;
- Suggestion to make the surveys more specific with broader range of marks;
- Suggestion to add surveys into June registration process not ideal because parents have moved on and beginning a new season;
- Suggestion if fill out survey in June then get entered for free registration as incentive;
- Question re: Is Zone providing mentorship for coaches who need help identified through surveys?
 - Trying too do this but player development comes first;
- Question re: How do we determine if surveys are being filled out in good faith?
 - Take into account there may be clashing personalities; if there is an issue, unlikely that survey will be the first time it is heard.

- U15A to become citywide league, \$125 tryout fee, 8 teams to start, partnering with SJHL so those will be team names, season similar to AA, provincial and citywide playoffs will be modified, will be an executive for the league with 2 coordinators for every zone, coaches picks short list of 12 prior to tryouts and then down to 8 depending on where kids land; Sept 12-18 tryouts, 180 players as many players who want can tryout, no limit; after first year will be like GSHL tryouts with returning players going to A,

- each zone with 2 player evaluators and 1 goalie evaluator; interlocking teams not part of it as of now; register for both zone and citywide;
- Will be a U13AA female;
