What a tremendous Kick-off Rally & Jericho March for the first 40 Days for Life campaign of 2020! Beautiful balmy sunny weather and a crowd of **more than** two hundred people—yes, **200!** gathered outside Planned Parenthood in Ann Arbor this past Sunday, Feb. 23. Young and old, families with small children and people in wheel chairs-- all joined together to pray, witness to life, and be strengthened by the prayers and inspiring words of attorney James Kresta, Rev. Christopher Thoma and Father Bill Ashbaugh.

Father Bill greeted those gathered with a beautiful opening prayer. Rev. Thoma pronounced those gathered to be “a battle field filled with valor, adorned soldiers who prove to be more than words, as you are those who will not stop until the lives of the unborn are protected and the world looks back on the devilish meat grinder facilities like Planned Parenthood, as we look back on Auschwitz.” Kresta spoke of his first pro-life witness while in his mother’s womb, and with great passion declared that “this was a great time to be pro-life”. As the crowd applauded in response to Kresta's words, his five young children broke out in cheers of "Go, Daddy!" and "Yay, Daddy!" to the delight of all present. Following the rally, Fr. Bill and Rev. Thoma led those gathered in a one mile march surrounding the abortion facility, singing and imploring God to “bring down the walls” as at Jericho.
