

# 40 Days for Life - Littleton

## KNOW BEFORE YOU GO!

Planned Parenthood location and hours:

131 W County Line Road, Littleton 80129

Mon, Tues 8:00 – 6:00 Wed, Thurs 9:00 – 7:00 Fri 9:00 – 6:00 Sat 9:00 – 3:00

**PRAY** – Even before you leave your house, pray that you will have a spirit of gentleness and love with everyone you encounter.

**PARKING** – *At this point*, we have no restrictions in the parking lot. Please be courteous and use parking spaces that are distant from the buildings in the strip mall.

During hours when all businesses are closed, parking near the sidewalk should be OK.

**WHERE TO PRAY & COLORADO BUBBLE LAW** - Generally speaking, prayer volunteers will walk on the north-south running sidewalk along Broadway. For safety reasons, please stay north of the driveway in that stretch, and don't walk back and forth across the driveway. If your time slot has lots of volunteers, some might consider praying on the County Line sidewalk, near that driveway entrance.

**\*\***The Broadway sidewalk puts us within 100 feet of Planned Parenthood's front door. Therefore, we may not approach anyone to get within 8 feet of that person, to talk to them, give them literature, or show our signs.**\*\***

There is a wider-than-8-feet stretch of grass next to the Broadway sidewalk. If prayer volunteers remain on the sidewalk, we will be in compliance with the Bubble Law in keeping our distance from those in the parking lot.

**SIGNS** – At this point, we do not have storage facilities to keep signs on site. It is not necessary for anyone to hold a sign. If you decide to make your own sign, please have a loving message. Graphic depictions of aborted babies are absolutely contrary to our mission of peace, love and mercy, and will not be tolerated.

**INCLEMENT WEATHER** – 40 Days for Life is an all-weather vigil. The commitment of people dedicated to prayer despite cold and wet conditions has been a powerful witness and cause for changed hearts. Bundle up!
