Summer Intern:

- The BOH summer 2016 intern is Anna Christanson, who has been appointed by DPH.

Hazardous Waste:

- \$15,000 passed at Town Meeting for funding purposes
- Work on collaboration between Sudbury and neighboring towns including: Maynard, Wayland, Natick, Needham, Winchester, etc. to coordinate a yearly usage schedule for residents.
