

**Cable Television Committee
Minutes
April 11, 2000**

These are the minutes for the Cable Committee meeting of April 11, 2000 at 7:30PM in Town Hall. In attendance were chair Jeff Winston, Peggy Fredericksen, Mark Thompson, and Marty Greenstein.

The meeting immediately went into executive session to discuss the negotiations. Because of the sensitivity of these negotiations, nothing may be reported. However, Mark Thompson continues to be in contact with Cablevision on the construction of the I-net. The architecture is now solidified and to a great extent consistent with what has been reported in the minutes of earlier meetings.

It may also be reported that there is no news on a Cablevision buyout.

We approved expenditures for Peter Epstein, our lawyer.

There is also no news on Metrocom, but Bell Atlantic received permission at Town Meeting to set up a hub for DSL near Fairbanks. This would allow them to extend their service throughout more of the town.

The meeting adjourned at 9 PM.
