Acceptance of minutes:

The CIPC voted to approve minutes

Community Center Feasibility Study - \$75,000 / Jim Kelly presented

Request will be that \$10,000 from Natatorium Article 18 from ATM 2012 be revoted for this project. CIPC hopes the balance of \$75,000 will come from private funds;

Unanimous approval to support revoting \$10,000 from Natatorium Article 18 from ATM 2012;
If other \$65,000 isn't raised the CIPC does not support the \$10,000

Unanimous approval to revote \$50,000 from Article 18 from ATM 2012

Revote of Police Station Article

The minutes read \$7.2 million; the correct amount should be \$7.5 million;

Unanimous approval to support the police station at \$7.5 million dollars.

CIPC Bylaw article discussion:

Statement from the CIPC for town meeting: The CIPC has discussed this proposal at length and supports it and recommends town meeting approve it. The committee believes that operating under the new bylaw will enable it to spend more of its time on projects of greater importance to the town and focus in greater depth on long term capital issues facing the town.
