CPC Projects:

Ironworks: John, the Iron Works representative will meet with Jim Hill and Bill Place to install the Cemetery posts and gates, and lock the gate. Bill will close the driveway.

Hearse House: It is boarded in with roof on and work is progressing.

Rev Cemetery: Kai has been paid for his work on the Revolutionary Cemetery. He will submit a proposal of additional work to be done. He will also fix the stones in the Mt. Pleasant Cemetery for \$7600 which has gone to CPC for approval.

Hosmer House Ceiling: It has been decided by the Town Manager that the Historical Commission will be in charge of the work. The contract has been signed, and work will start after the first of the year. Members of the Commission will be required to move all paintings and furniture from affected areas.

Loring Parsonage: Liz will be responsible for the Parsonage project.

FY10 CPC: Lyn will notify the appropriate people of a meeting on 2 December for the discussion of the three non-Commission requests to the CPC.
