The financial report was given by Liz. A special thank you recognition was given to Barbara for all her efforts in the store, rentals and donations. She gave a detailed report on her efforts in placing our items in different sites around town that are willing to sell our merchandise. Barbara is waiting for the 375 logo to be announced so that special ornaments can be made. Diana will see if the Society is willing to let us sell some of their new books.

4th of July - Twenty-five home-made pies will be for sale along with books and a yard sale at the Hosmer House. The house will open at 10 AM and will be closed for the parade and open for a short time afterwards. The house will close at 3 PM. Pat Howard is trying to get some more docents to help on that day. Pies are being made by the Villagers and each Commission member will also bake something to sell.

CPC Projects - Jim has committed to work on the Fire Suppression System during the summer when he has more time. The poison ivy needs to be removed from the Animal Pound before the mason can install more gray stones to match the present wall. The board across the top will be stained a chestnut color before the fourth as promised by Ben Walker. Jim also will work on getting the back hall door replaced. Jim Kelly and Lyn are working on bids for painting the Hosmer House. Some carpentry work needs to be done before the painting.

Signage - Lyn is meeting with the Sign Review Board and the Sudbury Historic District to present the plans for getting cemetery signs in each of the six cemeteries in town. CPC approved the plan and gave funding and Town Meeting approved it in May. Bob Leonard is submitting drawings and Precourt has quoted on granite posts. Lyn is also working with the DPW and Cemetery Foreman.

The Boy Scout Project of restoring the Wadsworth gazebo should be started after July 4th. Hopefully the new roof will also be completed soon. We have had other requests from Boy Scouts wanting to earn their Eagle Badge which we have sent over to the DPW.

The shed cabinet is being redesigned in order to hold more gardening equipment so Diana and Bill are working out the details.
