The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

This was a joint meeting with the Board of Selectmen to discuss the appointment of a new member to fill the vacancy left open by the resignation of Marianne D'Angelo on June 1, 2002. The Planning Board recommends the appointment of Michael Fee, who has been the Planning Board Associate Member for the past 12 months.

The Selectmen asked the candidate a few questions:

Mr. Fee's past experience includes Conservation Commission and the Recycling Committee of Watertown. His livelihood is primarily real estate litigation. He works well with other members of the Board, which is important with other Boards as well. Some personal goals include permit streamlining and zoning (use table revisions). Mr. Fee is very familiar with zoning bylaws in general and uses them in his practice. His litigation philosophy is to develop and administer rules fairly. Since development is typically adversarial, the Town must be careful to make its records so we are prepared for litigation.

Kirsten Roopenian expressed Sudbury's appreciation of Marianne D'Angelo's efforts in Town.

Motion duly made and seconded to appoint Michael Fee to fill Marianne D'Angelo's vacancy on the Planning Board effective June 1, 2002.
