To the Constable of the Town of Sudbury:

GREETINGS:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury qualified to vote in Town affairs to meet at the Lincoln-Sudbury Regional High School Auditorium in said Town on Tuesday, June 17, 1997, at 7:30 o'clock in the evening, then and there to act on the following articles:

ARTICLE 1. COUNCIL ON AGING REVOLVING FUND

To see if the Town will vote to authorize for FY1998, the use of a revolving fund by the Council on Aging for Senior Center classes and programs, to be funded by user fees collected; said fund to be maintained as a separate account, in accordance with Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 44, Section 53E 1/2, and expended under the direction of the Council on Aging; or act on anything relative thereto.

Submitted by the Council on Aging.

COUNCIL ON AGING REPORT: Classes and programs at the Fairbank Senior Center are self-funding. The Council on Aging requests Town Meeting approval for FY98 to continue using a revolving account to receive fees and pay expenses related to classes and programs.

ARTICLE 2. SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL ENTERPRISE FUND FY98 BUDGET

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, or appropriate from available funds, \$253,853, or any other sum, in the budget of the Solid Waste Disposal Enterprise for FY98, in addition to funds already appropriated, to be included in the tax levy and offset by the funds of the Enterprise, or act on anything relative thereto.

Submitted by the Town Manager.

TOWN MANAGER REPORT: This article appropriates funds to operate the Transfer Station and Recycling Center for FY98. Under this proposed budget, the Transfer Station and Recycling Center would be operated by the Sudbury Department of Public Works three days per week. The sticker fee would remain at \$170 per year. The budget also funds one household hazardous waste collection day.

And you are required to serve this Warrant by posting an attested copy thereof at the Town Hall at least fourteen days before the time appointed for such meeting.

Hereof fail not and make due return by your doing thereon to the Town Clerk, at or before the time of meeting aforesaid.

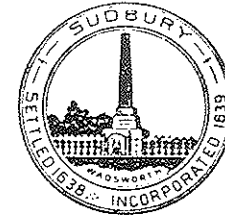
