Dear Sudbury Board of Selectmen,

On behalf of NSTAR Electric Company d/b/a Eversource Electric, we thank you for your comment on the Company's Environmental Notification Form and/or Draft Environmental Impact Report ("DEIR") submitted under the Massachusetts Environmental Policy Act ("MEPA") for the Sudbury-Hudson Transmission Reliability Project. In accordance with 301 CMR 11.16(5) and the Certificate of the Secretary of Energy and Environmental Affairs on the DEIR, we are writing to inform you that the Company filed a Final Environmental Impact Report ("FEIR") to the MEPA Office on Monday, July 2, 2018. It has come to our attention that there was a transmission error with the email notification that was sent previously with that filing. As a result, the FEIR filing was resubmitted to MEPA on Thursday, July 26, 2018, so that the public comment period can begin anew and be in compliance with all procedural requirements. The content of the FEIR has not changed and the resubmission contains only a revised cover for the FEIR document with a revised date, along with a formal submission letter.
