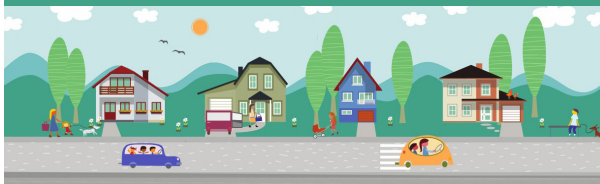


NEIGHBOR BRIGADE.

If you are currently experiencing a temporary crisis due to cancer, an accident, surgery, fire, a recent death in the family, a complicated pregnancy or other difficulty, Neighbor Brigade is here to help. Our caring volunteers can provide free and temporary assistance to help you heal and recover.

Examples of our free services include:



- Meals delivered to your doorstep
- Rides to medical appointments and/or errands
- Light household chores
- Dog walking and light pet care (non-boarding)

If you live in a town where we have a Neighbor Brigade Chapter, local volunteers are ready and waiting to help you and any family members. Are you experiencing a temporary crisis and could use caring support from your neighbors? Call or visit our

website to see if we have a Chapter in your town or city. If we do, you can request help online or over the phone. We ask for at least 48 hours notice to be able to fulfill requests. Our free services usually last anywhere from 1-3 months but can be extended.



Interested in volunteering? Neighbor Brigade is a perfect fit for anyone looking for a rewarding experience helping

individuals in their own town. You can sign up to help out once a week or once a year; our schedule is flexible and there is no requirement for how often you choose to volunteer. Some of our volunteer opportunities require background checks, and volunteers ages 14-17 must have written permission from a guardian in order to volunteer independently. Volunteers must have access to a computer or smartphone. To sign up today, go to our website and follow the application steps.
