

Mass Internet Connect: New a program created to provide fully subsidized internet service for Massachusetts residents who are unemployed and working with [MassHire](#) to search for a job. The program is scheduled to run through June 30th, 2021. There are 3 different internet providers available including Comcast (Essentials or a \$30 subsidy credit), Spectrum, and Verizon (hotspot). There is also an option to receive a free Chromebook device. MassHire will screen for preliminary eligibility, if eligible, MassHire will submit participant information for consideration by the internet provider. Personal information will be shared with the internet providers. Once enrolled in the program, each internet provider has a different set up process.
