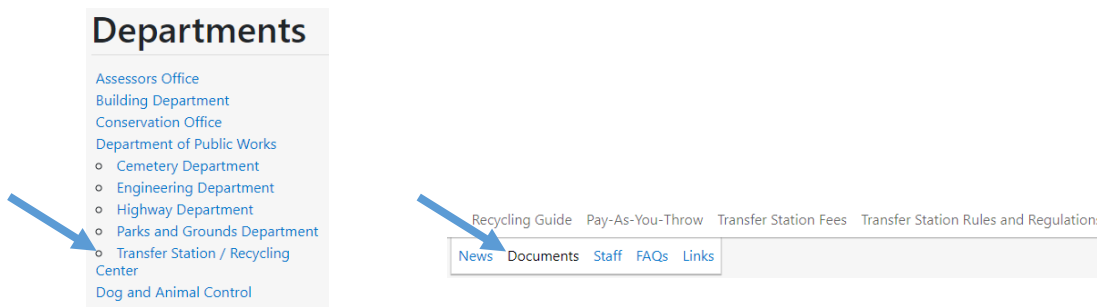


Transfer Station / Recycle Sticker Renewal Procedures During the Novel Coronavirus Pandemic

Dear Resident,

While the Public Works Department offices are still physically closed to the public, the application and subsequent issuance of permits continues to be offered. Applications are included with this mailing or they are available through the Town’s website: (www.sudbury.ma.us/transferstation/documents). These applications are easily downloaded from the Town of Sudbury main website (www.sudbury.ma.us). Click on “Departments” at the top of the webpage then simply navigate to the “Transfer Station/Recycling Center” page and click on the “Documents” link as shown below.
