- 1. Find a pro-life leader in your congregation to lead this effort. Turn this mailer over to that person.¹
- 2. Publicize the upcoming 40 Days for Life Campaign. The congregation needs to know their pastor supports this:

3. Provide a table or kiosk for signups.³

¹ Pastor is encouraged to be informed about the 40 Days for Life organization: Please navigate to 40DaysforLife.com, or scan the QR code shown above with a smartphone camera. The chosen leader should be able to get onto and navigate around the Salem Campaign website and be able to help sign up those who need help with a computer, or the leader should be able to sign them up him- or herself (Bob Snyder can promote the leader to Vigil Coordinator for this purpose). ² Publicizing can be through **(1)** promotion from the pulpit—the congregation needs to know their pastor supports this!, (2) presentation to the congregation of one of the short promo videos available (see QR codes and URLs above), (3) display of flyers as posters, (4) inserts and repeated announcements in church bulletins and other publications, (5) slides for the preservice announcement slide rotation, and (6) any other creative means you can invent. ³ This table or kiosk can be in the foyer or lobby of the church building before, between, and after services. A large flat-screen TV can be used nearby to display a looped 40 Days for Life promo video (muted, with subtitles—see QR code above). Helpers can stand by the table or kiosk to invite people passing by to check out the materials and sign up for hours to pray on the sidewalk. The leader may want to choose a particular day of the week to focus on to invite volunteers to pray there, though volunteers are welcome 7 am-7 pm any day of the week. If fear is an issue, Saturday and Sunday are days when Salem Planned Parenthood is closed and may be less intimidating times until fear subsides—historically it's been very safe in daylight there every day of the week. One hour per 40 Days is good for a start. More are encouraged, if possible, of course. Volunteers can invite friends to accompany them. We strongly urge that at least two persons be there at a time. Experienced volunteers are available to accompany first-time vigil participants. Contact Bob Snyder.
