

Suggestions for Topics of Prayer

Pray that we each submit ourselves this day as a living sacrifice to God, holy and acceptable to God. Pray that He would use you to rescue others who are perishing.

Pray for mothers going into the abortion facility that God would deliver them from evil and bring them away from those who profit from shedding innocent blood. That they would accept the free help and practical care from a pregnancy help center and choose life.

Pray for post-abortive women who cannot forgive themselves. May they understand there is no condemnation in Jesus Christ.

Pray for an end to abortion. Let us pray for the expansion of pregnancy resource centers in our community (and worldwide). Pray for Hope Pregnancy Clinic, St. Germaine Pregnancy Center, Michael the Archangel, Birthright.

Pray that those tempted to abort their baby realize their child is already present and already a real person whose heart has been beating since Day 21. Open their eyes, Lord. Send your protection upon every child still in the womb.

Lord, we are fearfully and wonderfully made. May that knowledge shape our lives and actions.

Pray for our nation for turning hearts away from God. Pray for repentance. We recognize we are in need of forgiveness as a nation. Cleanse us from all unrighteousness. We praise You for Your tender mercies and Your compassion that never fails. May Your Holy Spirit enable us to walk humbly in Your presence and may You be pleased to restore America so a generation not yet born may praise You.

Pray for our leaders nationally and locally.

Pray that those who have forgotten their purpose may discover it in God.

In You we live and move and have our being (Acts 17:28). You knew us before You formed us in our mother's womb (Jeremiah 1:4). It is because of You we are. May we find grace from You to affirm the being of every human and may we labor to make this truth known to the world around us.

May our words and actions in defense of human life proclaim to all the world that God alone is the Lord of life and death. He is the Giver of Life. We are made in His image.

Pray that all God's people awaken to the fact that we are our brother's keeper. May the example of the Good Samaritan fill the hearts and minds of all citizens. Lord, give us the same heart.

Lord, empower us with Your Holy Spirit to do Your will on earth. May we have a heart and zeal to save the poor (unborn children abandoned by their parents, their families, their loved ones) and release the oppressed (unborn children whose oppression has been legitimized by our government).

Pray that we each put on the full armor of God (Ephesians 6:12) for we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, rulers of darkness of this age, and against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places. (Put on the belt of truth, the breastplate of righteousness, and shod your feet with the gospel of peace, the shield of faith, the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit.)

Pray for the abortionists and all the workers in the abortion facility that they would be troubled in their soul regarding their work and would see truth. Pray the scales would fall off their eyes. I pray that those workers would see volunteers for 40 Days for Life as ambassadors of Christ, and may each volunteer be consciously aware at all times of Whom we represent.

Pray for God's strength and protection as we strive to protect human life. Matthew 25:31-46 says "...Assuredly I say to you, in as much as you did it to the least of these my brethren, you did it to Me."

Pray for pastors that they may not be distracted from the priority of caring for human lives.

Father, keep us from taking for granted the gift of children. Help us remember this heritage You have given us. Make us faithful stewards of these precious lives, that each generation might be raised in the nurture and admonition of the Lord. We ask this through Jesus Christ our Lord.
