Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil, Amen.

**Hail Mary** Hail Mary, full of grace. The Lord is with thee. Blessed art thou amongst women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. **Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death, Amen.**

**The Apostles' Creed** I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried; He descended into hell; on the third day He rose again from the dead; He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from there He will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen.

**On the 5 "Our Father" Beads of Each Decade:** Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, **in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.**

**On the 10 Small Beads of Each Decade:** For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, **have mercy on us and on the whole world.**

**After 5<sup>th</sup> Decade** Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

**Closing Prayer** Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion — inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments we might not despair nor become despondent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to Your holy will, which is Love and Mercy itself.

**A Prayer for Abortionist (All):** God our Father, we praise You and thank You for the great love with which You fashioned each of us within our mother's womb's . From the moment of conception and for all eternity thereafter, You love each one of us with the love that is totally unconditional. That same unconditional love led St. Paul from being a persecutor of your people to becoming one of Christ's disciples.
