

## 40 Days for Life: Spring 2026 Campaign, Charleston, SC

**Start Date:** Wednesday, February 18th at noon | **End Date:** Sunday, March 29th at noon

**Time:** 7 AM to 7 PM daily in one-hour increments

**Goal:** 2 or more people per hour

**Challenge:** Brand-new volunteers: 1 hour per week | Returning volunteers: 2+ hours per week

**Location:** Public right-of-way outside **Planned Parenthood, 1312 Ashley River Road**. Do not cross the yellow lines in the driveways or you will be trespassing. You can stand in the grass between the driveways or in front of their sign on the corner of Ashley River Road and Fuseler Road.

### Parking:

What used to be the Blair Center for the Arts at 10 Carriage Lane is now a marijuana dispensary and we do not have permission to park there. You now have three options:

**1. Parallel park on Winston Street** near the Speed Limit sign (about 3 spaces available) near the corner of Ashley River Road and Winston Street.

**2. Park at the Piccolo Hair Salon**, 1322 Ashley River Road, in the back right corner, in the gravel section. To park here, you must do the following:

- Important: Put a piece of paper on your dashboard that says 40 Days for Life.
- If there are already 2 cars there with 40 Days signs, park on Winston Street or at the Circle K instead.

**3. Park at the Circle K** at 1141 Old Towne Road. If you are facing the building from the front, park on the right side. Parallel park between the two red cones, or parallel park near the black barriers. When walking to Planned Parenthood from the Circle K, do not cut through the Jaunt Apartments. You can walk through the parking lot at the One Carriage Lane buildings.


**4. Fridays ONLY:** Park at Elevate Dentistry at 1318 Ashley River Road

**Circle K, 1141 Old Towne Road:**



Behind the Circle K, you can also parallel park along the brick wall (same side as the dumpster). Do not parallel park along the backside of the Circle K itself, nor block this through-way.
