

Former Abortion Doctor Haywood Robinson to Visit Kissimmee Following Landmark Victories for the Pro-Life Movement

Kissimmee, FL – As the pro-life movement gains historic ground nationwide, former abortionist and current 40 Days for Life director of medical affairs and education Dr. Haywood Robinson is bringing his powerful message of faith, victory, and life to Kissimmee on February 16, 2026. Robinson will be speaking at the Kissimmee Spring 2026 40 Days for Life Kickoff Rally at 5pm in the public right-of-way in front of the Kissimmee Planned Parenthood (610 Oak Commons Boulevard), rallying the local community to stay bold in the fight for the unborn.

"Since the historic overturn of *Roe v. Wade*, our mission has entered a powerful new phase, and the faithful efforts of cities like Kissimmee are driving real change," said Robinson. The national 40 Days for Life campaign has played a major role in shaping the post-*Roe* landscape, as more abortion facilities close, Planned Parenthood faces continued cuts to taxpayer funding, and more Americans embrace a culture of life. Robinson's visit comes as part of the global movement's effort to mobilize support, deepen local engagement, and celebrate these recent victories.

Robinson's visit to Kissimmee underscores the growing influence of the pro-life movement in a post-*Roe* America—and the power of local communities to make a lasting impact.
