

Former Planned Parenthood Manager to Visit Kissimmee Following Landmark Victories for the Pro-Life Movement

KISSIMMEE, FL – As the pro-life movement gains historic ground nationwide, former Planned Parenthood manager and current 40 Days for Life outreach director Ramona Treviño is bringing her powerful message of faith, victory, and life to Kissimmee on September 24, 2026. Treviño will be speaking at the Kissimmee 40 Days for Life Fall 2026 campaign kickoff rally from 12:00pm to 1:00pm at the Kissimmee Planned Parenthood, 610 Oak Commons Boulevard, Kissimmee, FL 34741, rallying the local community to stay bold in the fight for the unborn.

Treviño’s visit comes as part of the global movement’s effort to mobilize support, deepen local engagement, and celebrate these recent victories.

- **180+ abortion facilities** that shut their doors following local vigils

Treviño’s visit to Kissimmee underscores the growing influence of the pro-life movement in a post-*Roe* America—and the power of local communities to make a lasting impact.
