WORDS FOR REFLECTION

"It is not enough to 'proclaim Jesus.' For there are many different Jesuses being presented today. According to the New Testament gospel, however, he is historical (he really lived, died, rose, and ascended in the arena of history), theological (his life, death, resurrection, and ascension all having saving significance), and contemporary (he lives and reigns to bestow salvation on those who respond to him). Thus the apostles told the same story of Jesus at three levels—as historical event (witnessed by their own eyes), as having theological significance (interpreted by the Scriptures), and as contemporary message (confronting men and women with the necessity of decision). We have the same responsibility today to tell the story of Jesus as fact, doctrine, and gospel."

CALL TO WORSHIP

Isaiah 2:1-5

LEADER

It shall come to pass in the latter days that the mountain of the house of the LORD shall be established as the highest of the mountains, and shall be lifted up above the hills; and all the nations shall flow to it, and many peoples shall come, and say:
